

Suggested activities for your child to try to learn their Word Study Words.

1.) "Pyramid write" your spelling words.

You must write neatly! *Example: home h
ho
hom
home

2.) Rainbow Write

First write each word in pencil. Then, trace over each word three times. Each time you trace, you should use a DIFFERENT color crayon or color pencil. Trace neatly and you will see a rainbow!

3.) Write your spelling words two times each.

4.) Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.

5.) Write ten sentences using at least ten of your spelling words.

6.) Write a short story using at least ten of your spelling words.

7.) Blue Vowels

Write each of your spelling words. Using a blue colored pencil, trace over the vowels in each word. Remember the vowels are: a e i o u

8.) Bubble Letters

Write each of your spelling words in bubble letters. After you finish, color your words with crayon or colored pencils.

9.) Consonant Circle

Write each of your spelling words in a list. Then go back and circle all of the consonants in your words!

10.) Words Within Words

Write each spelling word and then write at least two words made from the same letters. Example: slide side lie lid led etc

11.) Word Search

Make a word search puzzle using your spelling words on the website Armored Penguin - <http://www.armoredpenguin.com/wordsearch/>. You will need a parent to help you get started. After making and printing your word search, find your words!

12.) Cheer Spelling

For each spelling word, make up a cheer or a dance, cheering each letter of the word.

13.) Skywriting

Skywrite your spelling words by using your arm to “write” the letters of each word in the air while saying them aloud.

14.) Squishy Writing

Trace your words on a freezer bag filled with a couple of tablespoons of paint and some squirts of hand sanitizer.

15.) Floor Spelling

Sit on the floor and trace each word directly onto the carpet with two fingers. Be sure to say each letter as you spell the word.

16.) Clap It Out

Clap your hands to each letter as you spell each word out loud.

17.) Stand and Sit

Spell each word by standing up for consonants and sitting down for vowels.

18.) Shape It Up

For each spelling word, form each letter with Wikki Stix®, pipe cleaners, toothpicks, craft sticks, or Play-Doh®. Be sure to say each letter as you shape it.

19.) Jumping Jack Words

Do jumping jacks as you spell each word - 1 jump for each letter.

20.) Hop and Spell

Hop on one foot as you spell each word.

21.) Finger Spelling

Use your finger and trace each word in a tray filled with sand, salt, flour, sugar, shaving cream, or whatever you can put in the tray (box lid, cookie sheet, etc.).

22.) Build-a-Word

Use letter tiles, letter stamps, or other letter manipulatives to make your spelling words. Be sure to say each letter as you build each word.

23.) Jump Spelling

Write one letter of the alphabet on a separate index card and scatter the cards on the floor. Jump to each card as you spell each word.

24.) Swinging Spelling

As you spell each letter, take a swing – golf, baseball, and tennis!
